Partnership 2.0

As of 12/1/22 we have 158 groups enrolled totaling just over 25,000 employees and over 58,000 members.

As of 12/1/22, we had 124 groups who have completed their 3-year contract commitment under Partnership and had the option of leaving the plan without an early termination penalty. Nine groups have decided to leave prior to 12/1/22 and one group left on 12/1/22.

We held two virtual Partnership Utilization & Program Overview meetings for current group contacts in November and those were well received.

As of 12/1/22 we still have 5 groups remaining totaling approximately 2,400 employees and just under 3,400 members.


